

## **HIST 179 – American History and its Veterans, 1890 through Today - 3 credits**

Students examine the role and impact Veterans contributed to and had on American History. Course content is contextual to the era. It emphasizes the role former members of the military played both in war and peace. How these veterans influenced outcomes is woven either by the student's own research and/or with facts from the Veteran's historical recognition of events. Their consequential impact on the America of yesterday and today becomes the basis for each student's thesis.

### **The Opportunity:**

**College history credit earned in high school!** 99.7% of enrolled high school students have successfully transferred Adams State University credits to their college of choice upon graduation, while in our programs. This dvd is provided at no charge for students registering for three (3) or more credits.
